EXCUSED WITHDRAWAL^(EW) WITH REFUND AND PASS/NO PASS



Here to Support You

We understand that due to the current COVID-19 crisis, some students may need to withdraw from a class(es) during the spring 2020 semester. While we want to support successful class completion, we understand some students would prefer to pause their studies and come back in the summer or fall. Withdrawals will be marked as an "excused withdrawal" on transcripts and refunds are available. Please read further to understand all the implications.



Excused Withdrawal(EW) with Refund

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, you will not receive a W on your transcript. Instead, you will see the following option on myGateway: **EXCUSED WITHDRAWAL WITH REFUND**.



This option is available when there is a natural disaster beyond the control of the student, including COVID-19. If Financial Aid **DID NOT** pay for your fees, you may be refunded for the following:

- Registration fees
- Student health fees
- Parking fees

Pass/No Pass

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, all Fullerton College classes have the Pass/No Pass grading option available for students. In other words, instead of taking a class for a grade of A, B, C, D or F, you can receive a Pass if you earn a 70% or higher in the class. Details on how to select the Pass/No Pass option will be shared with you soon.



Special Advisory Notes

Financial Aid: The Excused Withdrawal(EW) or Pass/No Pass option may impact your Satisfactory Academic Progress. You will have the option to appeal to the Financial Aid Office for future semesters.

Transfer: The Excused Withdrawal or Pass/No Pass option may impact your educational and transfer plans. You are encouraged to speak to a counselor before choosing this option.

Special Programs: Students in special programs such as Veterans and military affiliated students, international students, athletes, Promise, or CalWORKs should contact the respective programs for additional guidance before withdrawing from any classes.
