RE: Foster and Kinship Care Education 2020-21 Advance Allocation Memo

This memo provides allocation budget information for the 2020-21 fiscal year. The Chancellor's Office allocates funds for the Foster and Kinship Care Education (FKCE) categorical program exclusively for the training of adults interested in providing foster care for children in out of home placement. Funding is ongoing based on the number of unduplicated target participants served. The sources of funding are Prop 98 educational state funds and Title IV-E foster care federal funds for a combined program appropriation in the amount of \$9,772,987. Currently, there are 57 participating colleges statewide and the funding formula is unchanged.

Please see the attached Advance Allocation document for college allocation amounts. Colleges are encouraged to continue to monitor the State budget for any changes that may occur in the fall.

Expenditure reporting is required within 60 days after the end of the fiscal year. The Chancellor's Office will provide final expenditures reporting templates and technical assistance for completing the report during the last quarter of the fiscal year.
