

Friends of Fullerton Foundation Scholarships Fullerton College provides many scholarships to our students via the Friends of Fullerton College Foundation! Scholarship application season opens in the spring semester annually. *Deadline: Friday, April 7, 2023*

NOCCCD Asian Pacific Islander Faculty & Staff Association Scholarship

The NOCCCD Asian Pacific Islander Faculty & Staff Association offers APIA scholarships (\$300) for Fullerton College students who demonstrate – through their accomplishments in school or in the community – that they have the potential to be leaders of the future by having a positive impact on their community. *Deadline: April 14, 2023*

NOCCCD Latino Faculty & Staff Association Scholarship

This fund is established by the Latino Faculty & Staff Association in honor of Enrique "Kiki" Zuniga. Kiki served as a counselor at Fullerton College for twenty-five years. During his tenure, he played a pivotal role in changing the campus climate relative to serving underrepresented and low-income students. He was known as the counselor who reached out to non-traditional students to motivate and convince them to pursue their goals for a brighter future. He was dedicated to helping students and believed in the power of education to change lives. He was famously known for 'walking the quad" and making sure his students were in class. *Deadline: April 14, 2023*

NOCCCD Black Faculty & Staff Association Scholarship

This fund is established by the Black Faculty & Staff Association (BFSA: Cypress College, Fullerton College and NOCE: North Orange Continuing Education) in order to help underrepresented students continue their education. Each year twenty (20) students are honored and publicly recognized for their outstanding achievement at the Students of Distinction Awards Ceremony, sponsored by Student Life and Leadership. Each student who is selected to receive this prestigious award will receive a scholarship sponsored by Associated Students, Dr. Janet and Henry Emoto, Schlinger Students of Distinction, Fullerton College Faculty Wives, District Management Association (DMA), various donors from Fullerton College, and the Friends of the Fullerton College Foundation (funds may vary from year-to-year, depending on the availability of donations collected).

Students with the highest score overall from each category will be forwarded to the final selection committee, which will choose the final top two students who will each be awarded the "Distinguished Student of the Year" and will receive an additional scholarship. Additionally, Students of Distinction awardees will be given the opportunity to audition to be a student speaker for the annual Fullerton College Commencement ceremony. Only Students of Distinction are considered as student speakers for Commencement and it is a tradition and honor bestowed on each awardee.
